



Recycling and Household Hazardous Waste

Delaware County's Compost Farm will be open for your leaves beginning Monday, October 20, 2008, 7 a.m. - 4p.m. and will remain open Monday through Friday until December 31, 2008. We can also accept your leaves in January; however, you need to declare your loads. Please note that yardwaste (i.e. shrubs, tree trimmings, etc. will also be accepted); however, your driver needs to specify what is on the truck. Yardwaste and leaves **will not be accepted** if placed on the same truck as each is processed in our Farm differently.

Beginning Friday, January 2, 2009, we will accept loads comprised of Christmas Trees at the farm through Friday, January 16, 2009. If you are a municipality that intends to chip your Christmas Trees and/or yardwaste, A & A Enterprises (Rick's Tree Service) 2043 Bridgewater Road in Aston will accept chipped wood waste at no charge. To make arrangements, call Rick directly at 484-353-7100.

Additionally, we will open the following Saturdays from 7 a.m. to 1 p.m.; December 6th, 13th, and 20th as well as January 3rd. On January 3rd, however, be sure to declare your loads as either Yardwaste (Christmas Trees) or leaves. Again, **DO NOT** mix your loads.

In 2009 we will once again be open for yardwaste on the third Wednesday of each month from January through September from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Municipalities or your licensed contracted hauler may bring yardwaste only on that day each month. If you are not planning on curbside collection of yardwaste and/or if you don't have one of your own, please advertise Delaware County's Compost Farm, 2300 Concord Road, Chester as your designated Yardwaste Drop Off Site. (You need to have a designated drop off site if you don't collect curbside in order to qualify for Recycling Grants.)
