Delaware County Household Hazardous Waste Collection Events



Preventing waste in the first place is the best, least expensive method of disposal. For all waste items, we recommend that you follow the disposal options in the following order:

Reduce

Buy only what you need and return unopened cans. If you are near the end of a job and realize you need only a small amount to finish, exchange the unopened can for a quart.

Reuse

Use leftover paint for a second coat.

Recycle

Old Latex Paints can be blended together to produce beige or gray. Oil-based paints may also be mixed together; however, *Do Not Mix Oil-Based Paints with Latex Paints.*
